## Hosanna in the Highest!

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he, humble and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey."

Zechariah 9:9

Palm Sunday was the fulfillment of the prophecy given in Zecheriah 9, foretelling that the king and savior would come mounted on a donkey, just as Christ triumphantly entered Jerusalem.
